

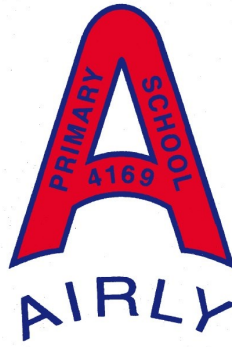

Remote Learning

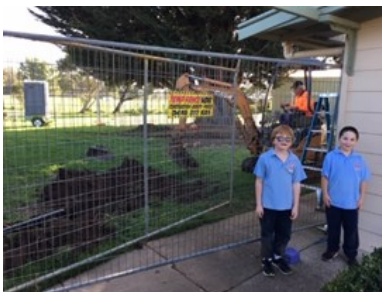

Ingredients

- 3/4 cup self-raising flour
- 1/4 cup wholemeal self-raising flour
- 1/2 teaspoon bicarb soda
- 1 cup buttermilk
- 1 egg, lightly beaten
- 2 teaspoons rice bran oil or cooking-oil spray

Basic Pikelets

Instructions

- Step 1** Sift flours and bicarb soda into a medium mixing bowl. Add buttermilk to mixture with egg and stir until batter forms.
- Step 2** Brush or spray a medium heavy-based, non-stick frying pan with oil; set over medium heat. Drop tablespoonfuls of batter into pan 2–3cm apart; cook for 1–2 minutes, or until small bubbles appear on pikelets' surface. Flip pikelets and cook for 1 more minute, or until lightly golden.
- Step 3** Repeat cooking process with remaining batter, transferring cooked pikelets to a plate.
